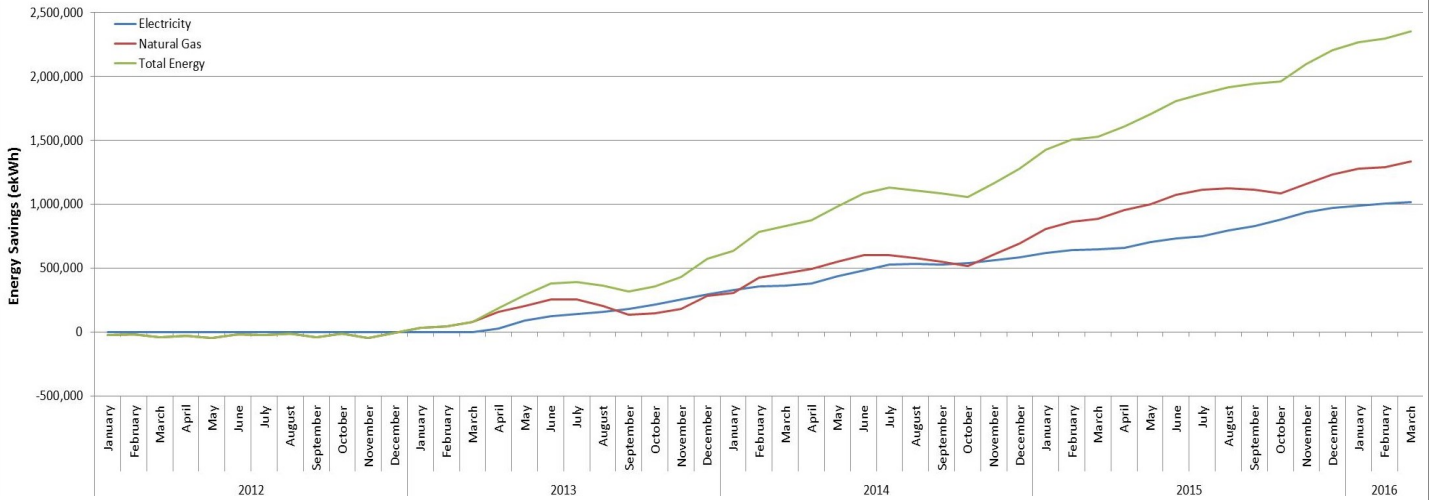


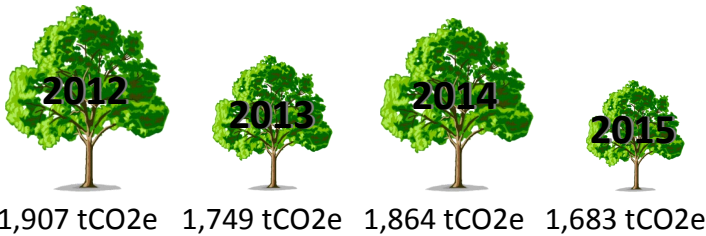

## Energy Savings from Completed Initiatives & Projects



| Initiatives & Projects Included  | Estimated Cumulative Cost Savings |

| Library Boiler Replacement & RCMP Furnace Upgrade (from August 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016)                                | \$3,500                           |

## Greenhouse Gas Emissions



**Total Cumulative Reduction: 425 tCO2e since 2012**



That's equivalent to greenhouse gas emissions from **89** passenger vehicles driven for one year!


