If we receive your application after October 5th, 2026, the time may be insufficient for mailing and receipt of the ballot; we recommend that you arrange to pick up a mail ballot package from the City of Cranbrook offices.
3. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot and documents are received by the Chief Election Officer on **GENERAL VOTING DAY October 17th, 2026**, before the close of voting at 8 p.m.

As per the [Local Government Elections Regulation](#), the following classes of documents must be accepted as evidence of identity or residency for the purposes of section 72 or 73 of the *Local Government Act*, or for the purposes of section 30 or 30.1 of the *Vancouver Charter*.

Two (2) Pieces of ID are required, one with name and current address and one with name and signature.

- BC Driver's License
- BC Identification Card
- Photo BC Services Card
- Non-photo BC Services Card
- Car insurance papers
- BC Care Card
- Social Insurance Number
- Citizenship Card issued by Government of Canada
- Property Tax Notice
- Credit card or debit card
- Utility bill such as coaxial cable services, electricity, gas, telephone services, water,
- Indian Status Card (a document, issued by the government of Canada, that certifies that the applicant is registered as an Indian under the *Indian Act* of Canada),
- Citizenship or membership card issued by a first nation,
- Citizenship card issued by Métis Nation British Columbia

PEO, at their discretion, may accept, the following:

- Valid current passport
- Birth certificate
- Firearms Licence
- Voter notification card
- Nexus Card
