


Council To Seek Public Input On Draft 2020-2024 Strategic Plan

Council endorsed the draft 2020-2024 Strategic Plan in principle Monday night, as directed administration to circulate the draft and get feedback from the public.

On February 7, 2020 Council and staff participated in a facilitated strategic planning session to identify the strategic direction and priorities for the next 4 years. This plan will act as the road map for steering the City's activities on behalf of the community with the core values incorporated into everything we do as we fulfill the vision.
