The City of Cranbrook is currently accepting applications for Auxiliary Fire Fighters. The Auxiliary Fire Fighters will work as team members to facilitate emergency response support to a variety of situations. This work is strenuous in nature and requires excellent physical fitness and coordination. Weekly evening practice/training sessions will be held and attendance is expected. Remuneration for services rendered is in accordance with the Auxiliary Fire Fighter Operational Guideline, a copy of which will be provided upon request.

Successful candidates will have the following qualifications:

- Valid BC Driver's License, Class 5 with Air Endorsement (**must attach Driver's Abstract**)
- Grade 12 Diploma or GED (**must attach proof**)
- Accredited IFSAC or Pro Board Fire Fighting Level 1 & 2 Certificate (N.F.P.A. 1001) (**must attach proof**)
- Excellent public relations and communication skills
- The ability to work as part of a team
- Flexibility to respond during emergency situations
- The availability and interest to attend evening and occasional weekend training sessions

The successful candidates will be required to provide proof of a recent physician's physical examination, and must meet minimum vision requirements and pass a physical ability test for the position. They will also be required to undertake a Criminal Records Check.

Interested applicants are invited to submit a covering letter and resume addressing education (providing required proof), and work experience, including three work related references.
